Ladies and Gentlemen:

At this time, there are 4 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Broward County and no cases at this time in Palm Beach, Miami-Dade or Monroe Counties. The system taskforce and senior leaders are closely monitoring all developments and are in continuous contact with our local and state health officials as we follow guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). Today, the CDC updated its screening tool for identifying patients under investigation for COVID-19. The new screening tool is attached for reference and also posted on the intranet.

I've asked our entities to review surge plans in the event it becomes necessary to use them, and we are evaluating other protocol and policy changes as the situation evolves. We have developed new guidance regarding large group meetings and events, travel and remote work. This information, as well as other frequently asked questions for employees, can be found in the attached document as well as on our intranet.

As Baptist Health employees, many of us are receiving questions from our patients and the community. Attached is fact sheet that can be provided to our community as needed as well as a document that you may use as a resource to refer to when answering general questions about COVID-19 and Baptist Health's response.
