SOCIAL MEDIA DO'S AND DON'TS

As the emergency response to the COVID-19 pandemic continues, it's important for employees to remember how you present yourself to patients and their loved ones, and to the community, both in person and online, is a reflection of Baptist Health. It is each employee's responsibility to protect patient privacy and act professionally. Even employees' personal social media usage reflects that responsibility. It's extremely important during this pandemic that employees practice good judgment when using social media to share information. Posts that identify patients, disclose patients' protected health information or contain confidential business data violate Baptist Health's Social Media and HIPAA Privacy policies, which can be found on the intranet. Following are some Do's and Don'ts to help employees exercise good judgment and avoid swift disciplinary action.

Do:

- Like and share posts from Baptist Health South Florida to your own social networks to help spread important information to the community.
- Support each other by participating in Baptist Health social media campaigns, such as #StayStrongSouthFlorida, #HeartsForHealthcareWorkers and #PineappleProud + Strong.
- If taking group pictures with your co-workers or team, practice social distancing and have no more than six people in the group.
- Remember even careful attention to privacy settings on social media do not equal privacy and posts can be shared beyond your intended audience.

Don't:

• Identify patients or family members or their health information in posts, comments, photos or videos.

- Post distasteful or inappropriate images or videos from patient-care or work areas, including outside screening locations.
- Engage in any form of harassment, including derogatory or inflammatory remarks, about patients, their loved ones, colleagues or Baptist Health.
- Post images or videos that show employees dancing or acting inappropriately on Baptist Health property.
- Share information, including photos or videos, that indicates Baptist Health's business practices, security measures, competitive data or future plans.
