Dear Baptist Health Family,

We remain cautiously optimistic as we move into April. While some parts of the country are experiencing a spike in new COVID-19 cases, we also continue to see positive signs of recovery. Vaccine accessibility is expanding and it is becoming much more widely available. Starting Monday, all Floridians will be eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine as prescribed by the FDA.

This Week's Numbers at a Glance

- Currently, there are **200** individuals throughout our facilities who are COVID-19 positive or suspected to be positive, which is a decrease of 16% from two weeks ago.
- We have discharged more than **13,500** patients who were treated for COVID-19.
- At Baptist Health, we have vaccinated a total of more than **38,000** people including eligible employees, medical staff and eligible members of our community, with more than **34,000** of those having received the second dose of the vaccine.

Vaccine Update

We continue to focus on vaccinating our frontline healthcare personnel while we support the wider vaccination efforts for our community. As of next week, every employee is eligible to receive the vaccine according to the state's guidelines.

Employees: If you would like to be vaccinated, please submit your request using <u>THIS FORM</u>. If you have questions about your appointment, please call 1-833-mybaptist.

As of Monday, we will be providing vaccines for individuals age 16 and older. Family members of employees and medical staff members, along with anyone in the local community may make an appointment to receive the vaccine with Baptist Health via our website, <u>baptisthealth.net/vaccine</u>, as supply allows. We notify our community about available appointments on social media. Please follow us @BaptistHealthSF for the latest information, and encourage your family and friends to do the same. We expect to continue to post new appointments as our supply of vaccine allows.
