



Covid-19 Vaccine

We are pleased to continue to support the effort to vaccinate our employees, medical staff and the community, in line with guidance from the state of Florida. We are making some changes to how you can request to receive the vaccine.

Employees:

We continue to offer vaccines for the following Baptist Health employees and medical staff members:

- Those who have direct contact with patients and who work in patient care settings in [priority groups 1A and 1B](#).
- Those who are age 60 and older.
- Those who are under age 60 and have been determined by a physician to be extremely vulnerable to COVID-19.
 - If you are under 60 and receiving the vaccine because you have been determined by your physician to be extremely vulnerable to COVID-19, you must attest that your physician recommended you receive the vaccine due to your high-risk condition. See [list of medical conditions specified by CDC as increasing risk](#). No additional documentation is required at this time.

Employees Only: If you are eligible for vaccination through the criteria above and have submitted your name to your leader but have not yet received a confirmation regarding a vaccination appointment, please resubmit your request using [THIS FORM](#). All new employee requests should be submitted using the form.

You should receive an email within two business days with a link to book your appointment, based on supply.

Please note: This form can only be used for your own vaccine request; you may not make appointments for anyone else using this form, and it cannot be shared outside the organization.

Your appointment for your second dose will be assigned to you when you receive your first dose. Before requesting your first dose appointment, please make sure that you will be available to receive the second dose of your vaccine approximately 21 days after your first dose vaccine (for those receiving the Pfizer vaccine) or 28 days after your first dose of the vaccine (for those receiving the Moderna vaccine).

Community:

Members of the local community [who qualify for the vaccine](#) per Gov. DeSantis's executive order may also make an appointment to receive the vaccine with Baptist Health via our website, baptisthealth.net/vaccine as supply allows. We will be opening a limited number of community appointments today at approximately 1pm.

We expect to continue to post new appointments as vaccines become available. We will be notifying our community about our appointment availability on Twitter and through our Instagram stories.
