



## Say Yes to the Covid-19 Vaccine

Dear Pineapple Family,

We are pleased to continue to support the effort to vaccinate our employees, medical staff and the community, following guidance from the state of Florida. Beginning April 5, all Floridians aged 16 and older are eligible to receive the vaccine.

### Employee Vaccine appointments

If you would like to request an appointment for the COVID-19 vaccine, please complete this [request form](#). You will be scheduled within the next few days, based on vaccine availability. You are encouraged to submit your request as soon as possible.

Please note: After submitting the appointment request form, you will receive an email from Baptist Health South Florida ([no-reply@email.baptisthealthsfl.net](mailto:no-reply@email.baptisthealthsfl.net)), and subject line: *[External] Schedule Your COVID-19 Appointment Now*, with a link to schedule your vaccine appointment. If you have not received this email please look in your junk or spam folders for the email.

Please call 1-833-MyBaptist if:

- Your link has expired and you still wish to schedule a vaccine appointment, to request that it be reactivated.
- You miss or need to reschedule your appointment for your second dose. Do not present at the vaccination site at an alternate date/time without rescheduling your vaccine first.

**Family members** of employees who are eligible to receive the vaccine and would like an appointment should book a slot through the community appointment link below.

### Community Vaccine Availability

We are also pleased to continue to support the effort to vaccinate our community. **We will be opening additional appointments at approximately 10 a.m. on Monday, April 5 for appointment slots on Tuesday, April 6.** Appointments will be available at the Miami-Dadeland Hilton on the campus of Baptist Hospital and at Boca Raton Regional Hospital. Note, those who are 16 and 17 years old must have a parent or guardian present to receive the vaccine.
