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CAFÉ/CAFETERIA DISCOUNT ENDING MAY 29

Since early last month, we have provided employees with a special temporary 50-percent discount in all on-site Cafés and Cafeterias. As we move forward in our economic recovery efforts and begin to re-open more of our business and service lines, the special COVID discount will conclude on **May 29**.

TEMPORARY REDEPLOYMENT PROGRAM

Baptist Health has developed a **Temporary Redeployment Program** to help secure temporary work opportunities, within Baptist Health, for staff who are employed in departments or centers that may be temporarily closed. The temporary assignments can last 30 to 90 days. This is a great opportunity for employees to temporarily fill current vacancies or support additional operational needs. Eligible employees will be able to register for the program via Employee Self Service (ESS/PeopleSoft). Talent Acquisition will then work with eligible employees and leaders to help secure the best candidates for each temporary opening. Candidates will interview with both Talent Acquisition and the temporary hiring leader. Employees will continue to receive the same salary from their original position throughout the length of the assignment.
